An abstract is a summary of described your idea for the poster presentation. The Poster session will be held in the Livingstone Museum, Zambia from Nov 2nd to Nov 5th. On the inaugural day each presenter will have 2-3 minutes to speak about his/her idea and theme behind the poster.

All accepted speakers will be ensured a discounted attendance fee.

The following information should be included with the abstract:

- Title of submitted poster, word count
- Name(s) of author(s)
- Author(s) ICOM number(s)
- Professional background up to 85 words
- Agreement that the poster can be made available on the partner websites

The abstract submission deadline is **September 10th**, 2024.
