


Dear Colleague,

We are pleased to announce that the second special project awarded by INTERCOM, in collaboration with MPR, ICOMON, ICTOP, ICOM Croatia, the Museum Dvor Trakošćan and the <u>Indonesia Hidden Heritage Creative Hub</u>, has begun with a pilot forum held on May 23, 2024 at the Castle of Trakošćan.

The topic: How to reduce museum business risks with adaptive management models in the area of capacity building, branding and museum investments was a first step to implement the ICOM Special Project and it will be followed by another international training event in Šibenik, Croatia in partnership with Europa Nostra, on June 6th.

The main conference in Jakarta is going to be enriched by the partnership with Indonesia Hidden Heritage supported by <u>EUNIC</u>. This is an excellent example of networking on a global scale and completely in line with the ambition of ICOM to implement the new Strategic Plan.
